

NL VAX PASS GUIDELINES

Who?

All entrants to the rink aged 12 and above must be checked for vaccination passports.

EXCEPTION: those aged 18 years and below who are **PARTICIPATING** in activity at the rink **DO NOT** need to show proof of vaccination.

Acceptable Proof of Vaccination

- 1) Electronic QR (NL VaxPass): **USE NL VAX VERIFY**
- 2) Picture of QR Code: **USE NL VAX VERIFY**
- 3) Paper Copy of QR Code: **USE NL VAX VERIFY**
- 4) Vaccination Record (paper): must show that they are **FULLY** vaccinated.

Identification

Ages 12 – 18 years old are required to show one piece of identification with their proof of vaccination. This must include their name and date of birth.

Ages 19 years and older, the identification must include a photo. If they do not have a photo ID, then two (2) pieces of non-photo identification that include name and date of birth are required.

The name on the identification must match the name on the proof of vaccination.

They can use the original version of their identification (card, paper or digital). They can also use a clear photocopy, photo or screenshot.

Out-of-Province Proof of Vaccination

If you do not have a valid Newfoundland and Labrador MCP card, you can use your vaccination record from your home province, territory or country to show proof of vaccination. Your proof of vaccination must clearly indicate that you are fully vaccinated (14 days since your last dose of a Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccine). You must also show identification.

Medically Exempt from Vaccination

People with approved exemptions will be issued a COVID-19 vaccination record QR code. Businesses and organizations will not be able to tell who has a medical exemption. If an individual states they are exempt but cannot show a QR code, they are not permitted to enter.
